SUBJECT: Policy Letter for Contractor Involvement to the 2004 Air National Guard (ANG) Air Force Reserve Command (AFRC) Weapons and Tactics Conference (WEPTAC)

1. The Air National Guard Air Force Reserve Command Test Center (AATC) will host the 2004 ANG AFRC WEPTAC from 18 through 22 October 2004, in Tucson, Arizona. Contractor and vendor participation, within specific guidelines, is encouraged. The following constitutes the AATC policy on contractor participation. Department of Defense (DoD) technical services support contractors are exempt from this policy.

2. Contractors and vendors are invited to participate in "Industry Nights" on Monday and Tuesday, 18-19 October 2004. Industry Night events will be held at the Tucson Airport Embassy Suites Hotel beginning at 5:00 PM each day and will include exhibits, display booths, and hospitality suites funded by individual contractors. Contractors and vendors are also invited to attend the banquet on Wednesday evening. All WEPTAC meetings will be considered "Government Only." Contractor participation in WEPTAC meetings will require pre-approval by the WEPTAC Chairman, Lt Col Gary Conlon [gary.conlon@aztucs.ang.af.mil](mailto:gary.conlon@aztucs.ang.af.mil).
